Sewing Instructions for:

A Pillow Case the Roll-up Way

Instructions are for one Standard size pillow case.

Fabric Requirements:

Main Pillow Case	¾ yard
Cuff	1/3 yard
Trim	1/8 yard

Step 1: Cut fabric to size (Assuming 40" - 42" inch wide goods)

Main Pillow Case fabric	27" x 40"
Cuff fabric	10" x 40"
Trim fabric	2 ¾" x 40"

Step 2: Press trim fabric in half lengthwise, with right sides out.

Step 3: Layer fabric.

- ✓ Place Cuff fabric right side up on a flat surface.
- ✓ Place Trim fabric on top of Cuff fabric, raw edges of Trim even with top raw edge of Cuff.
- ✓ Place Main Pillow Case fabric right side down on Trim fabric with all raw edges even.
- ✓ Pin all layers together with pins perpendicular to raw edges of fabric.
- ✓ Roll Main Pillow Case fabric up until it is within the edges of the Cuff fabric.
- ✓ Fold bottom edge of Cuff fabric over Trim and Main Pillow Case and re-pin so it's even with all other raw edges.

Step 4: Sew a straight ½" seam along the raw edge.

Step 5: Turn Cuff right side out by pulling fabric out of the sewn "roll" and press.

Step 6: Fold Pillow Case in half with wrong sides together, matching edges. Sew a scant ¼" seam along raw edges. Turn Case wrong side out. Sew a ¼" seam along long edge and bottom to finish the French Seam.

Step 7: Turn right side out and press.
